Parent / Teacher Meetings

Parent / Teacher meetings have been scheduled for Friday 27th October. On this day there is no school for all pupils to facilitate this. As you can all imagine, when your child is upset, this has a huge impact on their learning for the day. We have had particular problems with Pokemon and football trading cards and are therefore asking parents to ensure that these stay at home each school day. There may be occasions where a teacher asks for something to come in from home, which will form part of a child's learning. In this instance, each teacher will inform you when this is happening and what the item from home will be used for.
