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School Attendance and Lateness

Last week we had a meeting with our assigned Educational Welfare Officer. In this meeting we discussed how our school was faring in comparison with other schools in relation to our attendance figures. We are pleased to say that the overall picture for our school remains positive, but we still have work to do. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you all that your child should be at school every day, unless they have a valid reason for not being here. If your child is not going to be attending school, it is vital that you contact the school office and let them know the reason for your child's absence, as this must be recorded for both school and Educational Welfare records. If your child's attendance is not as good as it should be, the school must refer your child to the Educational Welfare Services. We have also noted that there are some children who are worryingly late for school on a daily / weekly basis. This too must be recorded by the school and this is then viewed by our Educational Welfare Officer. Being consistently late for school creates huge anxiety for your child as the school day has already begun and they are trying to catch up. As a school we will be writing out to you all in the next week or so, to outline how we feel we can best work together with you all, to ensure that every child in our school gets the best possible day at school.

NSPCC Assemblies & Workshops

The NSPCC are coming to school to do two assemblies for our pupils. They will speak with our P1-P4 on Monday 4th December and with our P5-P7 pupils on Tuesday 5th December. They will also be doing some workshops with our P6 and P7 children. The NSPCC are also going to host a parent information session on Tuesday 5th December at 2pm and we would encourage as many of you as possible to attend.
